SCHOLARSHIP BACKGROUND AND INFORMATION

The Norman Fraser Design Trust will award three Scholarships of £1,000 to 4th year full time students at Abertay University studying:

- BA (Hons) Games Design and Production
- BSc (Hons) Computer Games Application Development
- BSc Computer Games Technology
- BSc (Hons) Computing

And 4th and 5th year students on full time:

• BEng/MEng (Hons) Civil and Environmental Engineering

The scholarship is designed to alleviate financial hardship to students from areas of multiple deprivation, however students who are academically bright and driven with ambition to work in the civil engineering sector will also be considered. Students must demonstrate in their application why they have chosen to study a civil engineering degree and how they will benefit from the scholarship. The final decision will take in account of the student's motivational, academic, and financial circumstances.

Applications from student's resident in areas of multiple deprivation in Tayside will be prioritised.

ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA

To be considered for this scholarship students must meet <u>all</u> the following criteria. The student must be:

- Commencing year 4 (or year 5 of Civil and Environmental Engineering) for of either of the above listed courses at Abertay University in September 2024.
- Able to demonstrate a financial need for support in the application form.
- Able to demonstrate why they have chosen to study their degree of choice and why they want to work in their chosen industry.
- Be resident within the Tayside area (Areas include Dundee, Angus, Fife, Perth & Kinross)
- Willing to meet the award conditions set out below.

WHAT KIND OF FUNDING IS AVAILABLE?

Successful applicants will receive an award of £1000 paid over 2 instalments in the 2024/25 academic year as follows.

First instalment: TBC December 2024 - £500 Second instalment: TBC March 2025 - £500

AWARD CONDITIONS

Applicants must be willing and able to meet all of the following award conditions if successful:

1.	To write a Thank You letter addressed to the Award Donor within 4 weeks of accepting the award, submit the letter to <u>advisory@abertay.ac.uk</u>
2.	<i>To submit a short report about your experience undertaking your chosen opportunity by April 2024</i>
3.	To give permission for elements of your report/Thank You letter to be quoted for promotional materials
4.	To meet with the Donor at the Donors request

5. To take part in promotional activity relating to this Award

Completed applications and evidence should be submitted to the Advisory Service through the live form available on Connect, accessible with your student account.

Applications must be submitted with the **supporting evidence** detailed below.

An Academic Reference (i.e., from a Lecturer or Tutor) This must be a written/typed letter of support from your chosen referee and must be submitted by you along with your application. References should ideally be on headed paper or sent from a university or College staff email account.	
 Your Student Funding Award Letter (one of the following) SAAS Award Letter (available in your online SAAS Account) Student Finance Award Letter (all pages – usually available in your online Student Finance Account) Other Sponsorship Award letter
